Acupuncture offers an effective and exciting treatment modality for Dentists and Dental Care Professionals to deploy in their day to day practice to enhance their treatment outcomes. Acupuncture can produce some startling responses in both patient behaviour and management of pain, that can dramatically improve the outcomes of treatment sessions.

This two day "hands on" course will consist of lecture and practical small group training to give confidence in the use of acupuncture. The use and scientific rationale of acupuncture will be discussed, with a strong emphasis on diagnosis and management of conditions suitable for treatment in general dental practice. You will have ample opportunity to practice new skills, and by the end of the course will be able to use acupuncture safely in the dental context. The course will be taught by a dentist experienced in the use of acupuncture. Places are limited to ensure closely supervised practical tuition. *Not a day for needle phobics as you will need to practice on each other!*

Before the end of the course, you will have inserted many needles and be confident to try these procedures out with your own patients.
